2 Namaste everybody. I am very much pleased to present the annual report of Ambika Vidyalaya from 29 November 2023 to the till date. We the Ambikans believe that excellence is never an accident. It is always the result of high intention, sincere effort and intelligent execution. The team Ambika this year has been very fruitful one, as endless efforts were made to transform ourselves in the field of learning and has been successful in most of our endeavors.

3 With the vision of producing the generation of blooming buds as value based, skilled, culture oriented ,self reliant and independent, Nattoja foundation trust initiated Ambika Vidyalaya in 2014 with the holy blessings of Jagadguru Sri Sri Bharati Tirtha Mahasannidhanangalavar, as the first ever School under CBSE stream in Puttur Taluk.

With the honorary president Sri Lakshmisha Tolpadi, dynamic and soul of spirit acting president Sri Subramanya Nattoja, guiding lamp, correspondent Shrimati Rajashree S Nattoja, members of the trust Kumari Vaidehi S Nattoja and Chiranjeevi Srikrishna S Nattoja with the learned visionaries like Shri Purandara Bhat, Sri K Suresh Shetty, Sri Sathya Prasad Kote, Dr M S Shanoy, Sri Kanchana Ishwara Bhatt, Dr. I Srikanth Rao, Dr H Madhava Bhatt, Shri Balakrishna Borkar the affairs of institution are governed efficiently. Administrative officer Sri Ganesh Prasad, Public Relation Officer Sri Rakesh Kumar Kammaje, Campus Director Sri Rajendra Kumar assists the institution in its smooth functioning. Dr. Deepak Rai is the new PTA President for this academic year who is the strong binder between the school and the parents. I am very glad to share that CBSE

Board has extended the affiliation of the school for the next 5 year.

5. We have 26 well trained efficient graduate teaching staff and 14 non teaching staff headed by Ku. Malathi D as Principal and Shrimati Sujani M Borkar as Vice Principle

This year we have altogether 510 students from Pre kg to grade 10.

6. To make the journey of learning more fruitful all the classes are turned into smart classes. Also well set laboratories, computer lab with coding kits, well furnished math lab, library, mid day meals, school buses, sports and games corner, swimming pool are some of the facilities which the students are enjoying in the campus. Our Banker "Karnataka Bank" has donated a 52 seat School Bus to the institution under their CSR fund. The teaching faculty is extending its helping hand to all those students who need extra attention and support to learn. Every day evening from 4 to 5 remedial classes are conducted for such students in the school. To support students in crossing the hurdles of learning we have introduced counseling facilities for the needy. Smt. Shrilakshmi is guiding the students in this regard. To improve and to rectify the plans and proceedings, regularly parents meeting are arranged for all classes.

7. School offers English as first language, Kannada Hindi and Sanskrit as remaining languages. Apart from core subjects, Information Technology with coding and AI, Drawing, Physical education, Life Skill, Yoga, Moral Education, Bhagavad Gita classes are included in the curriculum. Everyday in the morning assembly, students are provided with apportunities to presents different contents like book review, day's impotance, introduction of medicinal plants etc. Shrimati Sharavati and team conducts yoga classes, for the interested students, Every Monday Kumari Priyashree handles Bharatanatyam, Tuesday martial art by Sri Shiva Prasad, Wednesday Skating by Shri Yashwant, on Thursday Yakshagana

by Shri Balakrishna Uddangala and Shri Satish Irde, Friday Scout and Guides classes by Shrimati Chandrakala and Sri Sathish Irde, in batches swimming classes are Conducted by Mr Yashwant A project on "Dharma Jagrithi" through "Dharma Shikshana" will be introduced very soon in the curriculum under the guidance of Shringeri Matt.

8. 2023 being the Decennial year, under the banner Dashambikotsva varieties of programs related to culture, health, education, social service etc were organized in the school. Some of the landmarks of Dashambikotsava are sessions by Sri Ramachandra Guruji, free medical camp to the public, free dental camp for the school children, Rama taraka japa yajna by the students, Carnatic classical concert by renowned artist Kum Surya Gayatri, sports and games for the parents, street play on drug awareness. On 24th and 25th of April with the gracious presence of his holiness Jagadguru Sri Sri Vidushikara Bharati Maha Sannidhanangal the valedictory of the Dashambikotsava was organized in a very unique way. During this auspicious moment Decennial Souvenir Bhumika was also released.

9. The second batch of grade 10 head registered an excellent record of 100% result in 23 - 24 Board Exam with 17distinctions 17first classes and 2 second classes. Kumari Sri Lakshmi, Chiranjeevi Jasweet, Chiranjeevi Abhinav Vasishtha

and Chiranjeevi Avanish Krishna where the toppers of the batch. The family of Ambika wishes the students a very bright future. In all the other classes also with colourful marks students got promotion to the next level.

I am proud to say that our first batch student Chiranjeevi Manvith S has cleared first level of NDA written exam.

10. The academic year 2024- 25 began on 29th of May in a traditional way.

Our Kindergarten tiny tots where welcomed to the academic year on 3rd of June with traditional rituals. General election was held on 4th June. Chiranjeevi B R Surya and Kumari Anagha V P of grade 10 were elected as head boy and head girl of the academic year. Election was held for different ministries and elected ministers were given different portfolio in the cabinet. On 5th June the World Environment day observed where Srimathi Lata G Bhat, ACF, Puttur, addressed the students. On 8th June investiture ceremony was held. Sri Mahesh Kaje, leading lawyer of our region who was the president of the decennial celebration administered oath during the ceremony. On the same day the newly admitted students were given the platform to exhibit their talents.

On 12th July students of 10th standard visited the Public Library Puttur and on the same day the DGM of Saraswati Credit sahuharda sahakari bank, Srimathi Bhavani Prabhu, addressed the students on banking system, credits and loans.

11. The people of this region witnessed very rare event on 19th of July. Thousands of people drenching in a heavy rain were stunned by the very presence of the Heroes of Kargil War, the youngest and highest gallantry awardee, Param Vir Chakra Yoginder Singh Yadav and Captain Naveen Nagappa. Tears were rolling down silently when the heroes were sharing their experience during war. On 26th July Kargil Vijay Divas was observed by the students by lighting the lamps in Amar Jawan. On the occasion Sri Aadarsh Gokhale enlightened the gathering on the importance of the day, Mugerodi Balakrishna Rai presided over the program. School got an opportunity to present a cultural event in town hall Puttur on account of Independence Day. A group of 50 students presented a dance drama "Janani" on this occasion. On 19th of August Sanskritotsava along with Raksha Bandhan observed. Srimathi Shashikla Varkardy, lecturer in Samskrita, at Ambika Maha Vidyalaya has thrown the light on importance of Sanskrit. Sarika H S faculty of Ambika CBSE, explained the relevance of Raksha Bandan. Like every year this year also Radhe and Krishna attire, bhajans, songs, dances, breaking the pots. On 20th of October Annual Sports meet was conducted in Kombettu Junior College ground. The annual meet was declared open by the national handball coach, PD of Vittal junior College, Sri Srinivasa Gowda.

Varieties of activities were organized regularly for our kindergarten tiny tots like color days, ashtami, Vana Mahotsavam, bhajans, shloka pathana, and other Activities, Chiranjeevi Pareekshith of IV standard is blessed with a rare talent of drawing the world as well as India map precisely by memory. This unique talent of Pareekshit is recognized by the public and social media.

15. Right from Pre KG to grade 10 students were engaged in one day educational outing to visit various temples, historical, cultural centers of our land also they had visits to banks, cooperative societies, dairy farming, factories etc.

The Scout and Guide team of 70 students of our school is involved in various activities like hiking, swachhata abhiyan, service to the society etc. 6 students have cleared tritiya sopana, 3 guides Kumari Hitali Prasanna Shetty, Kum. Saanvi,, Kum. Shravani of class 10 and 1 scout Aakash B Shetty have appeared Rajya Puraskar, the highest examination in Scout and Guide.

Students are given the opportunity to write several examinations. 170 Students appeared Olympiad of math, science, general knowledge, computer, social studies.12 students appeared Hindi examinations conducted by Hindi Prachar Sabha Madras. I am Happy to say that Mandira Kaje cleared Visharada Uttarardha exam. 6 students have cleared drawing junior grade and 20 have cleared drawing senior grade examination last year. High school students are made compulsory to write Ramayana and Mahabharata examination every year and take part in competitions of Dharmasthala Shantivana trust. Students have participated in Philo fest and Advaitakrishna of grade 10 secure third place in paper presentation. Raksha, Vaishnavi, Nidhi, Hrinmai, Inchara S Mayya, Yashas B bagged second place in folk song. 5 students have registered in INSPIRE science model, 4 teams will participate in INSEF Regional meet. Chiranjeevi Priyanshu, Chiranjeevi Parikshit have secured second place in taluk level science model competition conducted by the education department and represented Taluk in the district. Ambika team has participated in taluk Dasara

kridotsava and bagged several prizes. Kum. Drishana saralikana secured first in 100 meters, first in 200 m first in 4 x 100 relay. Kum. Hitali got third in discuss, Kumari Tanvi A Rai, Kum.Purvi, Kumari Trisha got second in 4 x100 M relay. Kumari Raksha, Kumari Mansvi, Kumari Adithi Shetty, Kumari Purvi got 2nd place in 4 x 400 relay, Trisha got 3rd place in 400 m race.

18. I am very glad to inform that this year, Ambika Vidyalaya has affiliated to Vidya Bharthi Akhila Bharathiya Shiksha Sansthana. Under Vidya Bharti this year students got various opportunities to exhibit their talents. In jnana vignana mela Mayur S Mayya, Shriya, Ruchika bagged 3rd in maths quiz, Anvita, Hrinmai, Prem got 3rd place in science quiz, Yugan Himanish got second place in science experiments, Priyanshu Aditi Rai, Kanishk got first place in science quiz and represented the district in the state, Niyati Bhatt secured second place in science experiments in the state, Sanvi K of class 6 got first place in state level math model competition and got selected to division level.

19. Under Vidya Bharti students competed in different sports events. Sunmay N of class 7 got 4th place in district level chess; Inchara S Mayya secured first in under 14 chess, in the state level and represented our state in the zone. In under17 Yogasana competition Niyati Bhatt of class 10 secured second place in the state level. In Karate Drishana Suresh Salikana for the first time in history of Ambika made herself to reach SGFI by securing gold medal in the National level. She also won gold in 100m, 200 m long jump and 4 x100 relay in zonal level and is going to represent Southern zone in the Nation. Along with her Kumari Hitali Prasanna Shetty is going to represent our Southern zone in the Nation in discuss under 17 girls who secure gold medal in the zonal level. Another feather in the cap of Ambika this year is in the event swimming. Chiranjeevi Pratyush L S Gowda bagged gold in 50 m backstroke, gold in 4 x100 medley, bronze in 50 M butterfly and got selected to SGFI Kumari Mahak Ravi Kumar Kothari secured gold in 100 m backstroke and selected to SGFI. Chiranjeevi Vardhin Deepak Rai secured gold in 50 M butterfly silver in 50 m breaststroke silver in 100 M breaststroke and got selected to SGFI. For the first time in the history of Ambika Vidyalaya 4 students are going to participate in prestigious SGFI meet, a dream of every sportsman. We wish these budding sports spirit to reach the greater heights in the coming days.

On behalf of family of Ambika I take this opportunity to pay homage.
